



Global IT Tennis Club Articles of Association (Draft)

Chapter I General

- Article 1** This organization is named IT 国际网球健身俱乐部 or IT 网球俱乐部 for short. Its English name is **Global IT Tennis & Health Club** or **GITTC** for short.
- Article 2** **GITTC** is a non-profit civil society organization incorporated on the voluntary basis by tennis lovers of the IT community from transnational enterprises in China and people from all walks of life at home and abroad who are concerned about the development of tennis.
- Article 3** Under the guideline of “making friends and keeping fit”, **GITTC** tries to advocate a vigorous and leisurely lifestyle which features moderate exercise and lasting interest in the form of a salon. Meanwhile, the Club also provides a platform on which people from the IT community can communicate and exchange views.
- Article 4** **GITTC** is jointly initiated and found by **Beijing Zhongguanchun Science Park Administrative Committee, Shanghai Informationization Youth Talent Association, Alcatel Shanghai Bell Co., Ltd., Shanghai Shanda Networking (Group) Co., Ltd. and Shanghai Symphony Telecommunications Co., Ltd.**
- Article 5** The address of **GITTC** is temporarily 21/F, POS Plaza, 1600 Century Avenue, Pudong, Shanghai.



Chapter II Membership

Article 6 GITTC is a membership club. The members are divided into group members and individual members.

Article 7 A team of more than three people authorized to be named after its enterprise or organization can apply as a group member of the club. In case a group member forms a match team, the leader shall be above the level of VP (including CIO) in the management of the enterprise or organization.

Article 8 IT officers, IT Managers, or other such veteran managements as CIOs of any multinational enterprises interested in tennis can also apply as individual members in their own names. In this case, they will form match teams by drawing lots or free combination

Article 9 Rights of the members:

1. All members have the right to participate in various matches organized by the Club;
2. All members have the right to have necessary drinks and dim sum and to use equipment and facilities provided by the Club free of charge;
3. Group members have the right to post or hang up their enterprise logos or team banners in accordance with relevant regulations;
4. Group members can also publish a brief introduction of their enterprises in a special magazine issued by the Club.

Article 10 Obligations of the members:

1. Support and comply with the Club's articles of association and regulations of the member's handbook;
2. Obey the general arrangement of match events;
3. Provide possible convenience and support to the events held by the Club;
4. Respect the legitimate rights and interests as well as the reputation of the Club and other members.

Chapter III Organization

Article 11 The supervising and coordination body of **GITTC** is the Board of Directors, which is composed of representatives of the initiating units and other members as well as recommended senior VIPs.

Article 12 The Board of Directors is set up with 1 honorary chairperson (if needed) and 1 chairperson respectively, 2 to 3 vice chairpersons; 1 secretary general, 2 under-secretaries general.

Article 13 The responsibilities of the Board of Directors:

1. Examine and approve the Club's Articles of Association (Draft) or subsequent revisions to the Articles of Association (Draft);
2. Vote on the candidates recommended for the chairperson and secretary general;
3. Give instructions for the events to be held by the Club;
4. Confirm the Club's annual event plan;
5. Materialize the support that the director units will possibly give to the Club's events;
6. Decide on other issues in which board consultation is indicated.

Article 14 A plenary session of the Board of Directors shall be convened annually in principle, a temporary session may be called if necessary. The members of the Board of Directors shall be informed of any decision approved or issue confirmed by the Board of Directors in the form of a summary of minutes.

Article 15 The Secretary General of the Board of Directors is responsible for the general coordination of the Club's daily operations.

Article 16 The Club sets a member service center, which consists of the General Planning Department, the Match Event Management Department and the Media and Press Relationship Department.

Chapter IV Events

Article 17 Events to be held by **GITTC** are mainly tennis matches and body-building and leisure-spending arrangements which facilitate the matches.

Article 18 Tennis matches are mainly divided into team matches and club matches.

1. Team matches, from April through September each year, will be held between the teams named after enterprises (group members) and the IT People Teams (composed of individual members) in cycles. They shall be sequenced by their accumulated marks. The top three teams will be gold medalist, silver medalist and bronze medalist of the team match respectively, and they will be awarded cups and prizes by the Club.
2. Club matches, the team of which consists of players selected from the top three teams in the team matches, will be amateur-player matches held between the Clubs from Beijing, Guangzhou and Shanghai or overseas teams of the IT industry.

Article 19 Information about the arrangements of the Club's events and other issues will be promptly released or systematically reported to the transnational enterprises' IT community in the form of a special magazine published by the Club.

Chapter VI Supplementary Articles

Article 20 For its sustainable and healthy development, the Club accepts endowment or donation from director units and members.

Article 21 The activities of **GITTC** shall temporarily undertaken by IT Times.

Article 22 These Articles of Association shall take effect when voted and passed by the plenary session of the Board of Directors.
